The California Student Aid Commission requires the Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships to obtain documentation that verifies that you have met the following eligibility requirements before you may receive your Transfer Entitlement Cal Grant.

- Graduate from a California high school (unless due to military orders required you or your parent/guardian to be out of state at the time of your graduation) or have completed a high school graduation equivalency (including GED or the California High School Proficiency Exam) on or after July 1, 2000.
- Be a California resident at the time of your high school graduation or its equivalent.

Your Cal Grant funds will be on hold until this form is returned with the appropriate documentation as indicated below.

Section A: Complete if you were **18 or older** when you graduated or completed a high school equivalency.

Submit a copy of your California high school transcript that indicates your graduation date or proof of equivalency.

Section B: Complete if you were **17 or younger** when you graduated or completed a high school equivalency.

1. Submit a copy of your California high school transcript that shows your graduation date or proof of equivalency **and** one of the following:
 - a. A copy of your parent/guardian's California state tax return for the tax year immediately prior to your high school graduation or equivalent (e.g. a 2002 CA tax return if you graduated in 2003).
 - b. If your parent/guardian did not file a Californian state tax return for the year requested, they must provide one of the following documents for the calendar year immediately prior to your high school graduation or equivalent.
 - a. Mortgage statement, lease or rental agreement with a California address
 - b. California voter or automobile registration
 - c. Utility bill for a California residence
 - d. Any other document that indicates a parental permanent address in California
2. Submit a copy of your parent/guardian's military records verifying relocation orders from California dated prior to your high school graduation or equivalent and at least one of the documents listed above for a period that predated the relocation orders.
