

2018-2019 DR. JUAN FRANCISCO LARA ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Community leaders, family, friends and UC alumni have collectively supported the Dr. Juan Francisco Lara Endowed Scholarship in recognition of his exceptional commitment to students during his 35 years of service at UCLA and at UC Irvine. He served as UCI Assistant Vice Chancellor of Enrollment Services and Director of the Center for Educational Partnerships.

The scholarship supports promising junior-level UC Irvine students who have participated in an academic enrichment and/or academic outreach program sponsored in whole or in part by the University of California or a comparable state, federal or privately funded program. The scholarship amount is up to \$3,000.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Current UC Irvine junior-level student. (If entered as a transfer student, you must have transferred from a California Community College).
- Full-time enrollment.
- Graduate of a California high school.
- Minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA.
- Open to all majors.
- Financial need as determined by the UCI Office of Financial Aid and Scholarships. If eligible, applicants must file a 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The FAFSA can be filed at www.fafsa.ed.gov. Students who are not eligible to file a FAFSA and qualify for the AB 540 fee exemption waiver must submit a 2018-2019 California Dream Act application. The California Dream Act application can be filed at www.dream.csac.ca.gov.
- Applicants must have participated in an academic enrichment and/or academic outreach program sponsored in whole or in part by the University of California or a comparable state, federal or privately funded program. (For a list of example programs visit <http://www.ofas.uci.edu/jflara>). *Please note that "participation" means that the applicant must be a beneficiary of such program and does not include working with or serving as a volunteer for such a program.*
- Must submit a resume
- Must provide one letter of recommendation.
- Applicants who transferred from a California Community College must submit transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended. A copy of the transcripts will suffice.
